Advance reservation requirements

- Reservations may be booked up to 12 months in advance of arrival.
- Full payment is required at time of reservation.
- We accept MasterCard, Visa, American Express and Discover.
- Maximum stay is 30 nights within a 45-day period per same household/address.
- A three-night minimum stay may apply for certain holidays at Turtle Beach Campground's discretion.
- Rates are subject to change without notice.
- Reservations comprised of multiple sites will be charged as individual reservations and will not be eligible for length of stay discounts.

Reschedules

- Reservations may be rescheduled one time free of charge up to two days prior to the scheduled arrival date. Additional reschedules are subject to a \$25 processing fee. Guests are responsible for any price increase resulting from a reschedule. Availability for reschedule is not guaranteed.
- Reservations may not be rescheduled until one year from the scheduled check-out date.

Cancellations

- All cancellation requests shall be made in writing and submitted to turtlebeachcampground@scgov.net
- Cancellations 48 hours prior to check-in are subject to a \$25.00 processing fee.
- Cancellations within 48 hours of check-in are subject to a \$25.00 processing fee, in addition to a \$50.00 rental cancellation fee.
- Reservations of a single night cancelled within 48 hours of check-in are non-refundable.
- No refunds will be made for early departures or late arrivals.
- Refunds may take up to 14 business days to process.

General campground use guidelines

- Check-in time is 1 p.m. and no later than 10 p.m. Check-out time is 11 a.m.
- No animals allowed except service animals.
- Filtered cigars and cigarettes are not permitted in the campground or the beach.
- Tiki torches, fire pits or other open flames are not permitted.
 Small propane grills are permitted.

- A gate code is required to enter a portion of the campground by vehicle. The gate code will be emailed to you before your scheduled arrival date.
- Campers are advised to protect their personal property.
 Turtle Beach Campground and Sarasota County assume no responsibility for theft, loss or damage occurring on site.
- A maximum of six overnight occupants are permitted per site.
- One camper or recreational vehicle and one sleeping tent, or up to two sleeping tents, are permitted on each site subject to occupancy requirements.
- At least one adult aged 18 years or older must be an overnight quest on each campsite.
- One vehicle is allowed per campsite, in addition to a camper or RV.
 Overnight parking is available for a fee for vehicles that cannot fit on your reserved site.
- Quiet time is from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. During this time, please use minimal lighting, quiet voices and do not run campers or RVs.
- Picnic area quiet time is from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Permitted uses of sites include tent or RV camping only and may not exceed maximum occupancy of six guests.
 The designated campground picnic area or space in the neighboring park should be used for social gatherings.
- Each site must be equipped with overnight camping equipment (tent, camper or RV). Camping in vehicles is not permitted, except for tents designed to affix to or sit on top of an SUV or truck.
- Campsites are back-in only. Campers and RVs must back fully into their assigned site.
- Washing of vehicles, campers or RVs is not permitted.
- No enclosed trailers, motorized water vessels or golf carts are permitted. Availability of parking at Turtle Beach Park is limited and is not guaranteed. No overnight RV, camper or trailer parking is permitted within Turtle Beach Park.

Campground reserved rights

- The drive area must be kept unobstructed. Turtle Beach Campground reserves the right to require guests to repark or move vehicles, campers or RVs if, in the campground's sole opinion, the drive area is impeded.
- Turtle Beach Campground reserves the right to ask campers to leave the campground in the event they do not adhere to rules and regulations. Refunds will not be issued for campers who are asked to leave.
- Please respect guests, park facilities, wildlife, plant life and the neighboring community. It is prohibited to remove any plants or wildlife from the parks.
- Turtle Beach Campground reserves the right to reassign sites or to require the removal of any camper that exceeds that exceeds site designated maximum length requirements.
