Artificial reefs have been constructed offshore in the Gulf of Mexico and inshore within Sarasota County to increase commercial and recreational fishing and diving opportunities and to build marine habitat.

- Use proper catch and release practices
- Use caution in shallow waters to avoid propeller cuts through sea grass beds.
- Use safe boating practices to minimize impacts to manatees and other marine life.
- Use a diver down flag when diving in the Gulf or inland waters.
